

Growing Home's CSA includes 7-9 main vegetables, plus an assortment of herbs or smaller produce items. The CSA has a higher retail value than what a CSA customer spends. At Growing Home, we grow particular varieties for our CSA customers and make sure CSA boxes are plentiful first and foremost. We host both a full share (16 boxes every week) and half share (8 boxes every other week). Our 2020 CSA will run from the weekend of June 20 - October 3 with one additional make up week.

Full Share

A full share is \$560 (price goes up to \$600 after April 30). Pick up starts the weekend of June 20 and continues each week until the weekend of October 3. Share is 16 boxes total.



Half Share

A half share is is \$260 (price goes up to \$300 after April 30). Pick-up starts the weekend of June 27 and continues every other week until the weekend of October 3. Share is 8 boxes total.

Sponsorship Share

A sponsorship share for \$1,120 (full share) or \$520 (half share) purchases two CSAs-one for you, and one for a family in Englewood where access to fresh, healthy food is limited.
